At the status conference, Community Union and CPED shall be prepared to discuss:

1. CPED's May 22, 2020 Status Update;
2. Community Union's May 29, 2020 Status Update (email at 6:12 a.m., email at 12:31 p.m.);
3. Community Union's May 28, 2020 request to prepare an amended Motion to Deny CPED and Korean Churches for Community Development Settlement Agreement, and

4. Participating in the evidentiary hearing via Webex, including stipulation as to certain exhibits, identity of witnesses, and examination time estimates.

Participants must follow procedural ground rules which will ensure an orderly remote hearing.

1. All counsel and parties agree to prepare their respective remote attendance technology and be connected at least 15 minutes prior to the time set for the evidentiary hearing;
2. All counsel and parties agree to adhere to all formal rules of decorum;
3. All counsel and parties will be muted upon entering the WebEx hearing. The Judge will call upon each person directly to speak. If it is not your turn to speak, but you wish to have the opportunity to be heard, please use the hand button next to your name;
4. Only the Judge and the speaking party may be visible on the screen; and if you have not been identified by the Judge to speak, you will be muted and not be visible on the screen;
5. Identify yourself by your full name before you speak;
6. Webex recommends headphones to reduce background noise and ensure optimal sound quality; and
7. Webex suggests using Google Chrome to run its applications.
